This year the program includes **600+** participating artists and **58** participating groups across **37** suburbs of Sydney to present over **240** events, exhibitions, workshops, markets, open studios and more.

The festival also extends into greater Sydney and regional locations including the Blue Mountains, Newcastle, the Illawarra, Shoalhaven and Central Coast.


