## **Object Space: April Phillip's Drop Let**

In Object Space's window gallery on William Street is April Phillip's *Drop Let*.

Using the droplet form across her design practice as a reoccurring motif of both pain and optimism, the shape, liquid suspended in time, is an iconic symbol in the emoji library - is it a drop of rain or a tear?

As part of Object Space on William Street, this installation includes a framed screen print, glass pendant light, glass vase, and glass drop tissue box, developed with Canberra Glassworks.
