



Funding success for Indigenous Edible Garden

Exciting news! Australian Design Centre has been awarded an \$88,000 grant for our project '[Indigenous Edible Garden](#)' in the NSW Government's My Community Project results announced today.

This project will allow us to deliver an educational garden offering a resting place in a culturally significant location to increase biodiversity, filter the air and buffer the William Street traffic noise. With ADC's Art and About project '[Gadigal Mural](#)' in Barnett Lane, the garden will bring back to the area the spirit of the traditional custodians of the land.

ADC will work with a range of partners including the local community, IndigiGrow - Australian Bushfoods, ASPECT Studios and the City of Sydney. The garden beds and existing courtyard will be redesigned with new seating and lighting with work to commence next autumn.

Thank you to everyone in the Sydney Electorate (1090 people) who voted for the project.

Congratulations to all the other successful organisations on their fantastic projects including two other Sydney

electorate projects Ruff Sleepers - dog washing for the homeless and Woolloomooloo Out Loud.
